Part A: Preliminary Examination

Paper I-(200 marks), Duration: Two hours.

- Current events of National & international importance.
- **History of India & Indian National movement**
- **Indian and World Geography**-Physical, Social, Economic Geography of India and the world.
- **Indian Polity and Governance** – Constitution, Political System, Panchayati Raj, Public Policy, Rights Issues, etc.
- **Economic & Social Development** – sustainable Development, Poverty, Inclusion, Demographics, Social sector Initiatives etc.
- General issues on **Environmental** ecology, bio-diversity and Climate change – that do not require subject specialization
- **General Science**

Paper II-(200 marks), Duration: Two hours.

- Comprehension,
- Interpersonal skills including communication skills;
- Logical reasoning and analytical ability;
- Decision making and problem solving;
- General mental ability;
- Basic numeracy(numbers and their relations, orders of magnitude, etc.)(Class X level), Data interpretation (charts, graphs, tables, data sufficiency etc. – Class X level);

Note 1: Paper-II of CS(P)E will be qualifying paper with minimum qualifying marks fixed at 33%.

Note 2: MCQs, objective type.

Note 3: It is mandatory to appear in both the papers of CS(P)E for evaluation, otherwise candidate will be disqualified.
