## **Part A: Preliminary Examination**

Paper I-(200 marks), Duration: Two hours.

- Current events of National & international importance.
- · History of India & Indian National movement
- Indian and World Geography-Physical, Social, Economic Geography of India and the world.
- Indian Polity and Governance Constitution, Political System, Panchayati Raj, Public Policy, Rights Issues, etc.
- **Economic & Social Development** sustainable Development, Poverty, Inclusion, Demographics, Social sector Initiatives etc.
- General issues on Environmental ecology, bio-diversity and Climate change that do not require subject specialization
- General Science

Paper II-(200 marks), Duration: Two hours.

- Comprehension,
- Interpersonal skills including communication skills;
- · Logical reasoning and analytical ability;
- · Decision making and problem solving;
- · General mental ability;
- Basic numeracy(numbers and their relations, orders of magnitude, etc.)(Class X level), Data interpretation (charts, graphs, tables, data sufficiency etc. – Class X level);

**Note 3:** It is mandatory to appear in both the papers of CS(P)E for evaluation, otherwise candidate will be disqualified.
